

Family Active Travel Map: South-West Cheltenham

This Family Active Travel map has been designed by the local community for the local community.

The map is part of a Sustrans Family Cycles project funded by Gloucestershire County Council Active Together Fund (2017) to make it easier for families to walk and cycle in Up Hatherley, Benhall and Reddings areas. Sustrans ran a summer cycling programme, which included a series of consultation events inviting families to design an online map highlighting **safe, family friendly** walking and cycling routes.

The routes connect frequently visited local facilities via the quietest roads and greenways suitable for families. The routes are based on ideas and experiences of the local community and are categorised depending on your method of travel and experience.

This map is intended to highlight local connections and is recommended to be used in-conjunction with other cycling and walking maps for journeys beyond the scope of this map. For more information go to www.thinktravel.info
