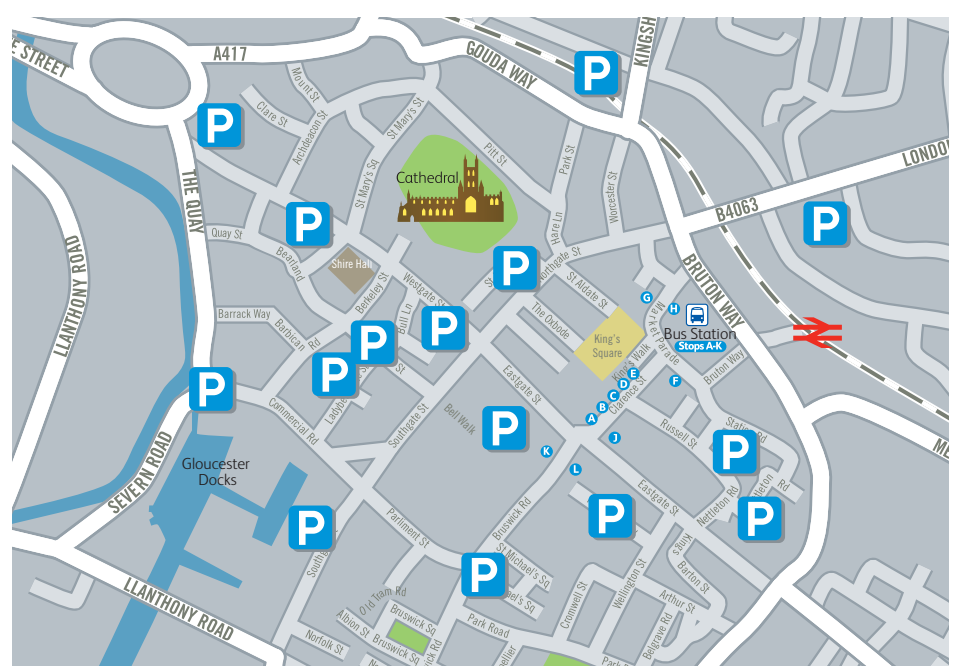

Blue Badge parking scheme

The Blue Badge scheme is designed to give registered severely visually impaired people and those who are unable or virtually unable to walk the ability to park close to the facilities and services they need to use, so as to improve their lifestyle, independence and freedom of choice.

Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) Barrier for Pre-Registered Blue Badge holders

On entry and exit of the car parks your car registration number should be automatically recognised and the barrier will lift.

Council run car parks are shown above.

Safe Places Scheme

Safe Places is a scheme which helps vulnerable people deal with any incident that takes place while they are out and about. Look out for the logo in shop windows.
